SCHOLARSHIP RULES

This is a one-time \$1,000 scholarship.

Scholarship is open to Iowa Charolais Breeders Association (ICBA) members' children and grandchildren.

Applicant, parent or grandparent must be a current ICBA member in good standing for 2 consecutive years and/or applicant is a member of the IJCBA for 2 consecutive years.

Applicant must have a 3.0 GPA in High School/ 2.0 GPA for College.

Applicant responsible for getting required documents to committee.

Scholarship is open to students planning to attend/or attending an accredited vocational school, college or university.

All applicants are evaluated on their individual scholastic performances, leadership, and citizenship experiences and livestock involvement.

Decisions are at the sole discretion of the ICBA scholarship committee.

Scholarship recipient will be announced at Iowa Charolais Breeders Association field day in conjunction with the Iowa Junior Charolais Breeders Association (IJCBA) show.

Scholarship payment will be made out to the student after providing first semester college or vocational school GPA transcript copy to committee.
